**NOTICE TO PROSPECTIVE JEWELLERY PERMIT APPLICANTS**

**1. POLICE CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE:** We have become aware that some applicants are awaiting the issue of their police clearance certificates in order to submit applications. Provided that this certificate is the only outstanding document required for you to submit a complete application for a Jewellers Permit, and provided that you submit proof of having applied for a Police Clearance Certificate by way of the receipt issued to you by SAPS, the Regulator will accept your application.

**NB: You will still be required to submit the original police clearance certificate once issued to you.**

**2. SARS TAX CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE:** Please note that no application can be lodged without a SARS Clearance Certificate.

**3. REGIONAL COLLECTION OF APPLICATIONS.** The Regulator will shortly advise both the venues and the dates on which officers will be available in Cape Town, Port Elizabeth, Durban and Kimberley to receive applications. Should you wish to make use of this opportunity to lodge your application, you are requested to please pay your application fee per cheque or bank transfer and to submit proof of payment (bank transfer copy) as no cash will be collected at the collection venue.
